### V.I.T.R.I.O.L.

Sometimes the children listen to the sounds of a machine as if they watch Mozart's symphony and sleep with that regular repetitive sound. Similarly, Adapa fell asleep with the enchantment of the soft sound and the vibration of the low-noise engines while the military transport rose above the dark clouds that looked like the messengers of the wrath of Sumerian Gods coming to tear down the Tower of Babel.

He began soon after his head fell down as a sign of deep sleep. In his dream, he was in space, like an observer waiting to watch what would happen a little later.

The Moon revolved around Earth as a silent witness of cosmic events as usual. Thousands of craters on her sad face that were the only proof of the Moon's millions-of-years-long testimony made her more than a silent observer.

She was neither in a fight with her glorious past because of these wounds, nor was she arrogant like a young soldier showing

off her scars from the war. A simple moon she was, dancing around a beautiful planet in a marvelous solar system and acting her role with love like an admirable actress. Her eternal dance was no different from a theater spectator acclaiming a magnificent show with a noble and silent whistle to prove the ancient hypothesis of Pythagoras, the unique voice of the planets and the Moon.

The icy calmness of the cold space at 2.6 Kelvin (-270.45 Celsius) was suddenly disturbed by the stargate opening across the Moon's dark side. First, it was a small point in space, attempting to break the eternal silence of the solar system. Like a stone creating series of waves on the surface of a calm pond, the small energy point turned into a gigantic spiral of energy, heralding its mysterious guest within seconds. Like a whirling dervish, the spiral of energy was lighting up the Moon's dark side with a crisp white light. The giant spiral of energy, which radiated energy like the mirror of Snow White's evil stepmother, turned into a window showing an unknown place in the universe.

Besides opening a black hole and keeping it running for a specific period was another matter, perhaps a harder one. As long as the destination was unknown, a black hole would show its strength like a mighty wrestler fighting back and guarding the entrance of this space highway. The laws of the universe would not let a wormhole to exist unless it had a final destination. This destination could both be another part of the same universe or another universe called the parallel universe. For galactic civilizations to master this technology, they would first have to understand the nature of multi-verses and learn how to navigate them if they did not want to end up in another universe with different laws of physics.

They had come to this planet a long time ago. A very, very long time ago. It was the long-forgotten memory of a time when spaceships were sent to many different solar systems throughout the galaxy to find a rare element to save their dying planet. When space scouts discovered that this planet rotating around a small star in the Milky Way Galaxy had the cure they had been looking for, he had immediately traveled Earth. The solution to their problem was gold. The only way to repair the atmosphere that protected their dying world by stabilizing the heat across the planet was to build an artificial protective layer in the atmosphere. After a while on this planet, they had understood that it was not easy to extract gold. The first ship to come here from the black hole had a crew of 50 people. The exploration equipment on board and the mining vehicles they carried would not be useful without a base on Earth. So, they would have to set up a base first. A small group of them would return to their planets to bring new equipment and supplies to the new base. This spaceship would also bring a new bigger crew to build the stargate base.

However, after coming to this solar system, they did not know that they would fall in love with Mars, whose beauty was legendary. Consequently, another mother ship and a team would come and settle in to establish a new civilization there. Meanwhile, Earth could still serve as a planet where they could rebuild a new civilization when their planets were dying. They also considered Mars. Although Enki had tried to persuade his father, Anu, the king of Nibiru, to establish this new base on Earth, Anu wanted to use Earth only to extract gold, because Mars' nature, gravity, and atmosphere were similar to their home planet. Planet Mars would

have been a more ideal place to start a colony for the people of Nibiru.

While Mars had a magnificent nature with amazing plants, simple life forms, especially in its massive oceans, Earth was also home to a prosperous diversity of animals. For Enki, the Earth was special because there were clever apes walking on their feet and hunting as a result of millions-of-years-long evolution from their ancestors, the monkeys. This universal miracle called evolution was proof of the cosmic consciousness behind everything. It always founds its way wherever life started in any form somewhere.

Life on Earth was far from Mars on the scale of evolution. Thus, interfering with genetics to artificially evolve human-like monkeys on Earth to work on gold extraction would accelerate their plans. Anu recognized and appreciated Enki's achievements but still asked him to follow Enlil's lead. He had experience as a military commander to lead this kind of mission. Enlil was his brother, and Anu was his father. What else could he do? He followed the orders. Beyond everything, Enki was a scientist, one of the best in their home planet Nibiru. Despite the first anger and embarrassment haunting his mind, it was apparent that establishing a base and a mining facility in an extremely hot, yet fertile region could be successful only under his leadership. The project was to succeed if they wanted to save their home planet before things would get worse. Everything depended on Enki's improvisation and scientific experience in this unknown

territory that was home to the giraffes, elephants, hippopotamuses, and many other wild animals. The new name given to him was "Lord of the Earth," that is, Enki, and he would always be remembered with this name.

Soon after his assignment, he built a temporary base in place in a place they called Abzu. After the transport of mining equipment, gold extraction had started, allowing Enki more time to observe natural life. They were not alone in that wilderness. Lulu Amelu was genetically designed to become the new human species with improved intellectual capabilities and would soon reproduce to populate the world to work for the visitors from the stars. These hunter-gatherer ferocious human beings could now walk and run upright, think strategically, make plans, develop a complex language and communication, socialize, create a culture, develop tools and weapons, build villages, and dominate the wild nature with their new advanced emotional and cognitive capabilities. To achieve this within a short time, Enki had to mix the genes of his species with the humanoids' genes to accelerate their natural evolutionary process. Nevertheless, the new humans were no match to their creators by knowledge, skill, and brain capacity. However, they were given all they needed to follow the footsteps of their cosmic masters' footsteps and reach their mental and technological capabilities within a few thousand years if they were given enough time to find their path. Knowing this, Anu had only one condition to approve the project - the new human species must not have the gene of longevity. Hence, they would not live tens of thousands of years like them.

The genetic modifications had taken longer than what they planned for. Away from their home planet, Enki had found himself working on a theory that was not used before. It was always kept as a theory due to ethical reasons, as highlighted by Enlil. They had to take another course to use the miracles of their advanced technology to come up with workers to help their small team in gold extraction in the mines.

Following the directions of King Anu, Lulu Amelu, the working man, was created in their likeness to be master of all that is on Earth. However, the first experiments were not successful because the first humans could not reproduce by themselves. Somehow, a genetically modified man and a woman, coming together, could not give birth to a child.

The solution had come from Anu again, saving Enki and his research team from a long period of fruitless striving. When he visited Earth after the opening ceremony of the stargate behind the Moon s dark side, he gave a piece of incredible advice at the meeting that evening.

"Let us follow the Grand Force's path, who created the universe from oneness. They would provide whatever else they needed if they did not break that golden rule.

Oh, how could they resist the urge of curiosity? The curiosity that attracted them to Enki would almost cause their destruction. They were not to enter the Forbidden Temple of secrets in that heavenly area. In Edin's experimental environment, all they were asked to do was to live as they wanted. They did not know that they were in an experiment, the last test before sending them to the world to start the first human settlement.

They were probably set by opponents of this experiment to enter the Forbidden Temple. Otherwise, these two naive people's minds and hearts could not be deceived that easily because they could not yet distinguish between good and evil, right and wrong. The rivals of Enki, who wanted to spoil the purity and naiveness of Adapa and Enki, were successful in their efforts to prove Anu that this project was a mistake from the beginning. They had been against any interference to the Grand Force's holy work, and now Anu could witness it with bare eyes. Adapa and his wife were expelled from Edin and sent to a life in the middle of wild nature. They would have to work from now on to make a living, which was very much different from their lives in Edin. Adapa would suffer by toiling and sweating.

Frustrated with the first man and his wife, Anu got angry also with those who set them up to go to the Forbidden Temple. He sent the servant of Enlil to live in exile in a remote part of the world, intending this decision to make his judgment for Adapa and his wife fairer.

During and after this unfortunate event, everyone had missed asking an important question - why did Anu ask Enki to forbid Adapa and his wife to enter the forbidden temple? Enki would understand the missing link many years later. It was tempting to ask someone not to think of a pink elephant and accuse him of thinking of it. Adapa made a decision. He had found what he was looking for in the search for the Truth, and his first job would be to talk to Belgin when he arrived at Eden Lab. He would learn more about Sufism, the 1400-years-old wisdom teaching that reflected its effects in Belgin's everyday situations and attitudes. For this, he

had to learn that universal Islam in Anatolia, not the veiled Middle-Eastern version but the esoteric version of it. Anatolia, which had been the crossroad of many of the most influential civilizations in the world's history, had been a unique melting pot for people and cultures but also religions. According to Heavenly Religions, monotheistic religions had started in Harran, the southeastern Anatolia, with Abraham. According to recent archeological findings, first organized sanctuaries were in Gobeklipete 12,000 years, unlike how they expected the historical timeline to progress.

He would learn the last religion of God that accepted all the prophets and previous religions. Islam was the religion that considered God beyond everything instead of deifying a person and did not belong to a single nation or a society, but all of humanity. It was the only way to learn the secrets of Sufism because Sufism was like a beautiful dress on the body of Islam and would lose its meaning without it.
